THE CHALLENGE

SLAB's existing system landscape was complex, with two separate ERP environments. It was running finance and procurement E-Business Suite on-premises and used a shared service E-Business Suite with another public body for HR and payroll. With a complex upgrade to Fusion imminent, SLAB had to develop a roadmap for future use, taking into account the existing environments and internal skills sets, as well as the business needs.

SLAB had to decide between moving everything to the E-Business Suite managed service, or consolidating their systems on Oracle Cloud. As an existing Oracle E-Business Suite user for 18 years, SLAB were aware of the capabilities of Oracle Cloud applications.

The Scottish Legal Aid Board (SLAB) is an executive nondepartmental public body of the Scottish Government. Established in 1987, the organization manages legal aid in Scotland, including whether aid is granted, investigating legal aid fraud, and overseeing the quality of work performed by firms and solicitors who deliver the work. The Scottish Legal Aid Board was the first Scottish Government organization to make the transition to Oracle Cloud.

THE SOLUTION

Inoapps implemented finance, i-expenses and procurement in the Cloud, including sourcing and invoice scanning, alongside Oracle Cloud HCM and Global Payroll.

By consolidating business processes onto one system SLAB is assured of greater visibility of its activities across the organization.
